A report was made to the council about the permits for cleaning out the bayou. The Corps of Engineers Permitting Division informed the Town that no permit was needed to clean out Wilson Bayou.

The Mayor reported to the Council that the final paperwork for the R.I.S.E., 5013 (c) organization has been completed and volunteers were contacted to serve on the board of directors. The proper paperwork will be filed with the appropriate agencies and then the organization can formally meet.

A presentation was made to the Town Council about the possibility of purchasing a new Mahindra tractor and finishing mower. The council asked for several price quotes from different dealers.

The Mayor and members of the Town Council were presented with a copy of the Town of Simmesport's Emergency plan for the gas system as required by federal law. They were also given a copy of the Elected Officials survey to fill out as required by federal law.

Another presentation was made to the Town Council about annexing land into the Simmesport Corporation limits. The plan is to annex property on Yellow Bayou, Green Acres, and land belonging to the Avoyelles Parish Port Commission. Each of the annexations will be treated independently.

The Avoyelles Council on Ageing made the town aware that there were roof leaks and possible water damage in the Senior Center. The Town agreed to look into correcting the problems.
